* Canberra Preschool Society Inc. Constitution (2007):

16 (2) A nomination shall be made on the prescribed form, in [Appendix 5](#) of this Constitution, signed by the nominator, a seconder, and by the nominee consenting to be so nominated, each of whom must be members of the Society.

(3) A nomination shall be lodged with the Secretary not later than seven (7) days prior to the scheduled date of the election. If and only if insufficient nominations for the vacancies to be filled are duly lodged in this way shall any nominations be permitted or received after that time.

Note: The effect of the above is that if seven days prior to the scheduled election there has been exactly one valid nomination received for each Executive office, then those nominees shall be unopposed.

18 (3) Elections shall be held at any General Meeting for regional representative positions vacant or due to fall vacant at that time, in like manner to the elections for Executive offices. In this subsection "General Meeting" includes the Annual General Meeting.
