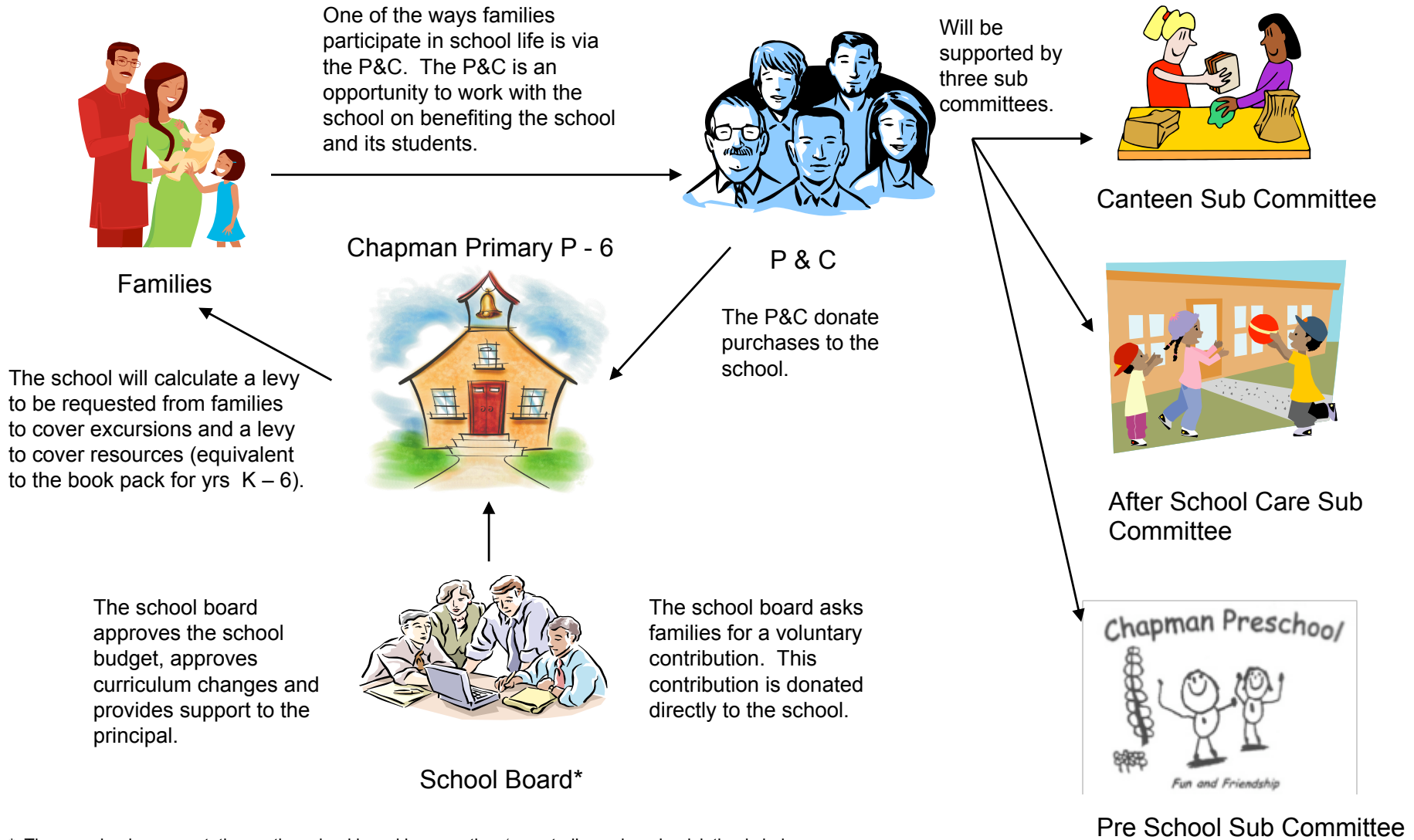


# Proposed Amalgamation Model – Preschool and School as at 27/07/2008



\* The preschool representative on the school board is currently a 'co opted' member. Legislation is being changed to allow the representative to be a voting member of the board. Note that preschool is the only year of school that has its own identified member.

## Chapman Preschool Parents Committee

### *Purpose*

- to create an environment where families are encouraged to be part of the preschool and school community.
- to ease families into school life and to assist with the transition from family life to an educational setting.
- to organise social activities for preschool families.
- to create a forum to engage in conversation about the pre school experience.
- to support pre school staff.
- to raise funds for the preschool as per funding model.

### *Committee Arrangements*

- Fundraising members, President, Vice President, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurers?, Secretary, Assistant Secretary (newsletter),

## Chapman Preschool Funding Model

### *School Funding*

- the school will pay for items which are essential to run the program e.g. staff, cleaning, photocopier, first aid replenishment, printer ink, paper.

### *Class Budgets*

- the school will give the preschool staff a class budget which will be used to purchase items to support the program they are running e.g. craft supplies, cooking ingredients.

### *Chapman Preschool Parents Committee*

- the parents committee may choose to fundraise to add to the program run by the preschool e.g. replenishment of books, replacement of outdoor equipment. Note that it is envisaged that all items purchased by the committee would be donated to Chapman Primary School.

### *P & C*

- the P&C may contribute to the preschool program in a similar fashion to the parents committee. The preschool will also benefit from donations made to the whole school e.g. outdoor infrastructure.
